

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE MEETING
October 5, 2010

In Attendance: Councilperson Hardman, Councilman Roberts, City Administrator Harrill, Sandy Willis.

Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 5:00 by Chairman Hardman. There was not a quorum present; therefore no decisions were made only matters of discussion.

Councilperson Hardman announced that the Waynesville Youth Football League has agreed to clean the downtown square area 3 times a year. They have already completed the fall clean up. Great Job! Mr. Harrill announced that Mr. Pete Berry with MoDOT received the bids for the GW Lane project and that the bids came in lower than projected. The project is scheduled to be completed by August 2011.

1. DREAM Announcement: Mr. Harrill discussed the selection of the City of Waynesville as a 2010 DREAM Community. The next step is to contact Ms Kim Martin with MDFB and the team of experts to formulate a plan. Councilperson Hardman had a list of projects to consider:

- a. Parking Lots
- b. Sidewalks on North Street
- c. Permanent Farmer's Market
- d. Façade
- e. Houses on the hill
- f. Bulletin board on I-44

2. "It's All Here", Nov 5, 2010: Councilperson Hardman discussed the Chamber sponsored program "It's All Here". The City of Waynesville is very supportive of the Chamber and this event.

3. Last Third Thursday of the Season: October 21 will be the last event for this year. The events will start again next spring.

4. Safe Routes to School Project Update: Mr. Harrill informed that the City had a public hearing and are working with the engineer to acquire the necessary easements. If anyone has concerns about this project, the City and or engineer will meet with them individually.

5. Roubidoux Enhancement Project Update: Mr. Harrill state that the City may look at possibly doing project by itself instead of combining the bids with the SRTS projects.

6. Rt 66 Tree Replacement: Mr. Harrill will do further research on Dogwood, Redbud, Crepe Myrtle and Service Berry trees and bring the information to the next meeting.
